

# Congratulations to the 2006 Joseph Leo Mackin, Jr. Building and Driving Our Future Scholarship Program Recipients!

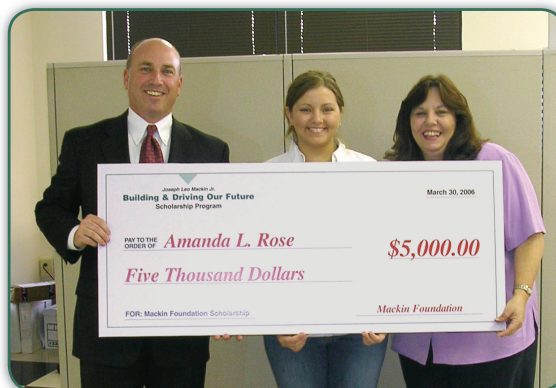
