Applications must be received by March 12, 2011 to be considered for scholarships awarded in April. The committee appointed by Interlock shall review and select the winners of the Interlock Scholarships. All selections are final and subject only to information being current and valid as per the applications. Interlock reserves the right to periodically review, amend or terminate this process.
